National minorities in Sweden include the Sami, who are an indigenous people, the Swedish Finns, the Tornedalers, the Roma and the Jews. The minority languages are Sami, Finnish, Meänkieli (Tornedal Finnish) Romany Chib and Yiddish.

Special laws have been adopted which entitle individuals to use Sami, Finnish and Meänkieli in dealings with administrative authorities and courts of law in the geographical areas (administrative areas) in which these languages have traditionally been used and are still widely used today.

This document gives guidelines for a character set – with certain accompanying obligations – containing the letters and other characters that governmental agencies must be able to use for writing personal names, corporate names and geographic names for computerized processing.
