**Prof. Dr. Peter Vogel** is Professor of Family Business and Entrepreneurship, holder of the Debiopharm Chair for Family Philanthropy and Director of the Global Family Business Center at IMD. Peter works with enterprises globally on organizational regeneration through intrapreneurship, leadership development, strategy, governance and change management.

Peter has published in peer-reviewed academic journals, has wrote a number of books and book chapters as well as scientific and practitioner-oriented reports. His work is frequently referenced by leading newspapers and other media outlets and is a regular conference speaker, including TEDx, the Global Economic Symposium, the St. Gallen Symposium, and others. Prior to joining IMD, Peter served as Director of Custom Programs and Business Development at the Executive School of University of St.Gallen, Assistant Professor of Technology Entrepreneurship at the University of St.Gallen, as well as Managing Director of the Center for Entrepreneurship and the Swiss Startup Monitor Foundation.

Peter is the founder and non-executive Chairman of the Delta Venture Partners AG as well as an Associate Partner of the Cambridge Family Enterprise Group. He is part of the expert network of the World Economic Forum (WEF) and is an alumni of the Forum's Global Shapers community. He is part of the Futurework Forum, a global think-tank focused on the future of the world of work. Peter earned his Ph.D. in Entrepreneurship EPFL in Lausanne, and an MSc and BSc in Engineering from ETH Zurich and Georgia Tech.
